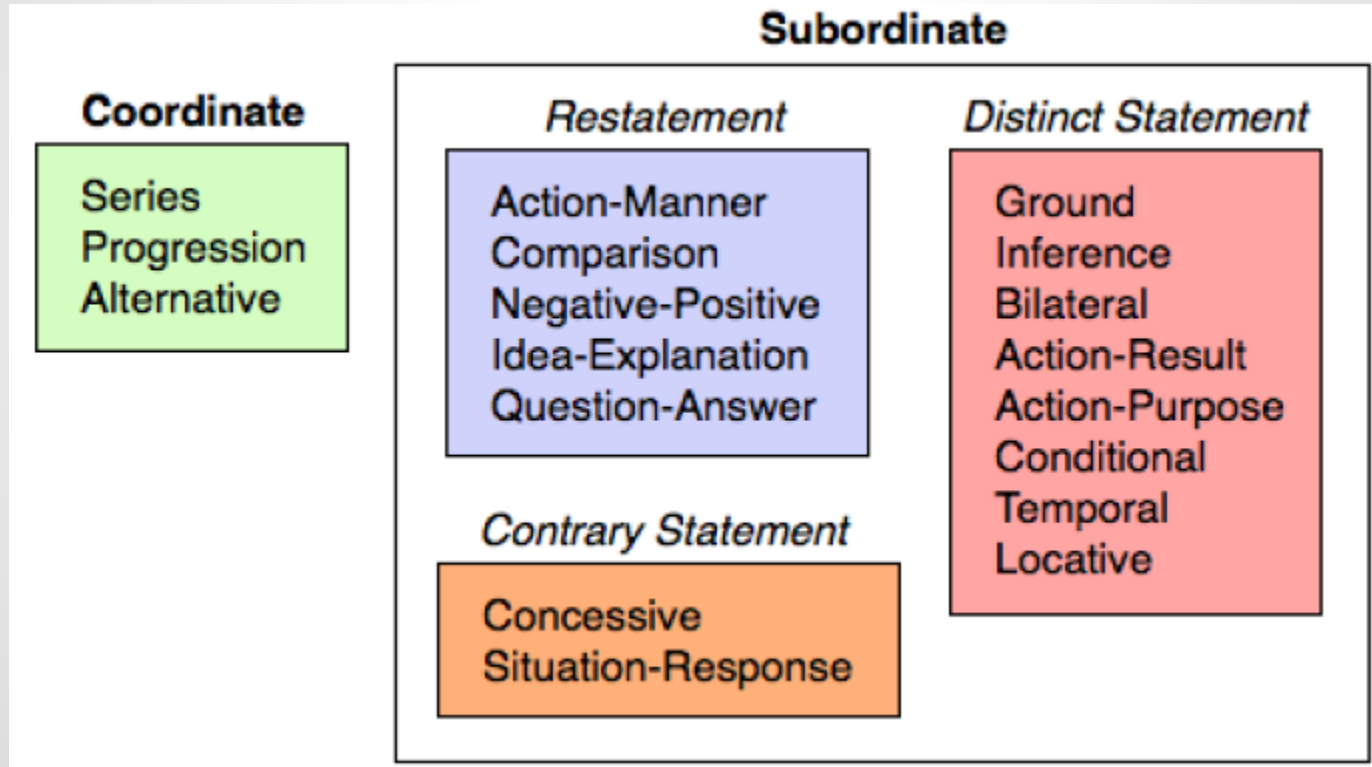

# Propositions (verbal clauses)

*Basic Rule:* Each proposition should contain one verb.

*But do not count:*

- Simple substantival clauses
- Helping verbs (I am going to the store) vs (I am happy)
- Complementary verbs (I want to eat)

*You may at times count:*

- Prepositional phrases (I ran in order to finish)
- Implied verbs (He talks like his father [talks])

# Propositions (verbal clauses)

*Basic Rule:* Each proposition should contain one verb.

*But do not count:*

- Simple substantival clauses
- Helping verbs (I am going to the store) vs (I am happy)
- Complementary verbs (I want to eat)

*You may at times count:*

- Prepositional phrases (I ran in order to finish)
- Implied verbs (He talks like his father [talks])

# Propositions (verbal clauses)

*Basic Rule:* Each proposition should contain one verb.

***But*** sometimes you may want to make a judgement call.
